Be on the lookout for the special 4-H camp edition of our newsletter coming in March!





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








### Recipe of The Month



Buying Kentucky Proud is easy. Look for the label at your grocery store, farmers' market, or roadside stand http://plateitup.ca.uky.edu

\*\*Aups rresh green beans, trimmed and cut into 1-inch pieces and siliced 1-inch pieces 4 pound fully cooked ham, 3 cups nusse potatoes, unpeeled and cubed 2 small onlons, thinly siliced 1 teaspoon salt 2 tablespoons com starch 2 small onlons, thinly siliced 1 teaspoon salt 4 teaspoon salt 5 cup cold water

Place green beans, potatoes, onions, carrots, ham and the nine cups water into a large soup pot; cover and bring to a boil. Reduce heat to medium and to a boil. Reduce heat to medium and simmer, uncovered, about 45 minutes or until the vegetables are tender. Remove the pot from the heat and add the salt, black pepper, garlic powder and half and half. Return to heat and bring to a simmer again. Combine corn starch and

the ¼ cup cold water in a small bowl.
When simmer begins, **combine** the corn starch mixture into the soup and stir well.
Allow the soup to remain on the heat for 5-7 more minutes while it thickens. Yield: 12, 1 cup servings

**NUTRITION FACTS:** One-half cup of unseaso green beans has 15 calories, is low in fat and sodium and provides fiber, vitamin A and

**SELECTION:** Choose slender, firm, smooth, crisp beans with slightly velvet-like pods with a bright, green color. Bean pods should be free of blemishes and have small seeds.

STORAGE: Beans can be stored unwashed in plastic bags in the refrigerator crisper for 3 to 5 days. Wash just before preparation. PREPARATION: Wash and remove stems and strings. Cook by steaming in a small amount of water until tender-crisp, about 5 to 8 minutes. They can also be cooked directly in soups or stews. Green beans go well with seasonings such as chives, dill, marjoram, mint oregano, thyme, lemon, mustard or onion.
